12/14/26 CWW to Dr. Bailey: Prof. Reed states that C. is doing fairly good work and has made a good showing in vital statistics, altho he is not a brilliant student.

Prof. Gregory reports C's work in sanitary engineering as "pretty fair". Exams. in this course were marked "fair" and "good" and he was reported as "very good" in reading. In view of difficulties with English, CWW considers this record more than satisfactory.

12/15/26 C to CWW: He has received a letter from the Mayor of Malaga, who is chief of City Health Dept., stating that the City Council would like C. to be permitted to do some special work on preventive hyg., bacteriological analysis, and treatment of Mediterranean Fever and trachoma, as they want to establish in Malaga a prophylactic service to check these diseases which are so prevalent.

CWW replied that it will be possible to arrange for C. to participate in at least part of program which his chief has outlined.

10/7/27 CAB-FFR: Arrangement for C's. studies satisfactory, but Dr. B. suggests that C. spend about two weeks at end of fellowship seeing tbc. control work in France.

12/22/27 C-CWW: C. to have tonsils and adenoids removed during Christmas vacation.

12/24/27 Dr. Howell-CWW: C. has completed all work for C.P.H. and has been recommended for that diploma. Has applied for registration for degree of D.P.H. but at last meeting of Faculty it was decided that application could not be accepted. (May go to Harvard).

1/4/28 CWW-C: Two alternatives for study (1) Harvard School of P.H. during Jan. Feb. and March to devote practically full time to study of child hyg. Part time might be spent studying tbc. and venereal disease activities of City Health Dept. trachoma hospital at Rolla, Mo. (2) Detroit City Health Dept. until end of May, and for June and July arrangements could be made as noted above.
